The Guidelines for filling up of Lapsed seats under Lateral Entry Scheme during the academic year 2010-2011 is given below.

As per directions given in Government letter cited, the Principals are informed that

"In respect of All India Council for Technical Education's Fee Waiver Scheme, lapsed seats shall not be filled up under the Lateral Entry Scheme and the seats under this scheme shall not be carried over to the next academic year."

The Principals are permitted to fill up the seats that remain lapsed during the First year B.E. / B.Tech. Degree admission with Diploma / B.Sc. candidates under the Lateral Entry Scheme in respective branches. The categories of lapsed seats that are permitted to be filled up during Direct Second year Lateral Entry admission are given below:

1) Seats that remain unfilled in any branch during the First year admission within the Sanctioned Intake.

- 2) Seats that are left vacant due to discontinuance of students whose admission have been approved by this office on the condition that the student name has been removed from the rolls of the College / concerned University and the student has been issued TC by the Institution. Such discontinued student cannot seek re-admission in the Institution in future.
- 3) Seats that remain vacant due to transfer of student from one institution to another in the respective branch on the condition that transfer orders have been issued by this office and the student has been issued TC to join the other institution.

The Principals are hereby informed that the above 3 categories of lapsed seats only are permitted to be filled up. In any case, total admitted strength in third semester of any branch should not exceed the permissible intake.

The Principals are requested to scrupulously follow the above guidelines. Further the eligibility norms for admission to Lateral Entry Courses is enclosed.
