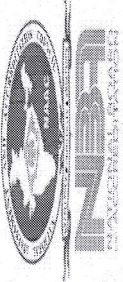

The AICTE Doctoral Fellowship (ADF) 2025-26 supports full-time PhD research in AICTE-approved institutions, offering a monthly stipend of ₹37,000–₹42,000, plus a ₹15,000 annual contingency grant for up to five years.
