1. INTRODUCTION AND CONTEXT

In an increasingly globalized world, international education has become a cornerstone for building a competitive and successful career. Recognizing the growing aspirations of students to pursue postgraduate studies in renowned international universities, the Continuing Education Cell of Akshaya College of Engineering and Technology (ACET) organized an expert talk titled “Pathways to Higher Studies Abroad.”

The programme, held on May 14, 2025, was exclusively arranged for third-year students, a critical juncture in their academic journey where they begin to make definitive plans for their future. The primary goal of this initiative was to demystify the complex process of applying for higher education overseas and to provide students with a clear, actionable roadmap, thereby empowering them to turn their global academic ambitions into reality.

2. OBJECTIVES OF THE PROGRAMME

The session was meticulously designed with the following key objectives:

- To Inspire and Motivate: To ignite students' interest in global academic opportunities and instill the confidence required to pursue them.
- To Inform and Educate: To provide comprehensive, accurate, and up-to-date information regarding the entire study abroad application lifecycle, from university selection to visa processing.

- To Provide Strategic Guidance: To equip students with practical strategies for building a strong application profile, including preparation for standardized tests, writing effective Statements of Purpose (SOPs), and securing impactful Letters of Recommendation (LORs).
- To Address Financial Concerns: To offer clarity on the financial aspects of studying abroad, including tuition fees, living expenses, and detailed information on available scholarships, grants, and educational loans.

3. INAUGURATION AND WELCOME

The programme commenced at 10:00 AM in Conference Hall – I. The session was formally inaugurated by the Faculty Co-ordinator, Prof. C Rajasekar, Assistant Professor (Selection Grade) from the Department of Mechatronics. In his welcome address, he extended a warm welcome to the esteemed resource person and the assembled students. He highlighted the institution's commitment to providing holistic development opportunities and emphasized the strategic importance of planning early for higher studies. He encouraged the students to engage actively and make the most of the expert guidance being offered.

4. KEYNOTE SESSION BY THE RESOURCE PERSON

The highlight of the event was the expert talk delivered by the distinguished Resource Person, Dr. V.S. Akshaya, M.E, PhD, PDF. With her extensive experience as the Assistant Director of Higher Education & Foreign Languages and as a Professor at Sri Eshwar College of Engineering, Dr. Akshaya provided an insightful and highly engaging session.

Her presentation was structured to cover the entire process in a logical, step-by-step manner:

Part I: The Strategic Blueprint for Studying Abroad

Dr. Akshaya began by outlining the significant advantages of an international degree, such as exposure to cutting-edge research, development of cross-cultural competencies, and enhanced global career prospects. She then detailed a strategic timeline:

Profile Building: Emphasized starting early by maintaining a strong academic record, participating in extracurricular activities, and undertaking relevant internships or projects.

Country and University Selection: Provided criteria for shortlisting universities based on course curriculum, faculty expertise, research output, university rankings, and post-study work opportunities.

Standardized Tests: Explained the purpose and preparation strategy for key examinations like GRE (for MS), GMAT (for MBA), TOEFL, and IELTS (for English proficiency).

Part II: Crafting a Winning Application

This segment focused on the qualitative aspects of the application, which often act as key differentiators:

Statement of Purpose (SOP): Dr. Akshaya provided a masterclass on writing a compelling SOP, stressing the importance of a genuine narrative that connects a student's past experiences with their future aspirations and their reasons for choosing a specific course and university.

Letters of Recommendation (LORs): She advised students on how to choose the right professors for recommendations and how to provide them with the necessary information to write a strong, personalized letter.

Resume/CV: Guidance was given on structuring an academic CV that effectively highlights a student's skills, projects, and achievements.

Part III: Financial Planning and Scholarships

Addressing one of the biggest concerns for students, Dr. Akshaya dedicated a significant portion of her talk to funding and finances. She discussed:

An overview of the cost of education in popular destinations like the USA, UK, Canada, Australia, and Germany.

A detailed guide on finding and applying for various scholarships, fellowships, and assistantships (both Teaching and Research).

Information on the educational loan process and the documents required.

5. INTERACTIVE QUESTION & ANSWER (Q&A) SESSION

Following the presentation, the floor was opened for a Q&A session. Students participated enthusiastically, posing a wide range of questions regarding specific course choices, visa interview preparation, part-time work regulations, and prospects for Master's degree & Ph.D. admissions. Dr. Akshaya addressed each query with patience and provided practical, personalized advice, which was highly appreciated by the students.

The career guidance programme successfully achieved its intended objectives. The primary outcomes for the participating students were:

He also highlighted the excellent higher education opportunities available in Germany and other German-speaking countries, known for their high-quality academic programs and strong research facilities. Mr.Sivanunni explained that German language certifications from the Goethe Institute are globally recognized and can significantly bolster student’s qualifications, making them more competitive in their careers.

During the session, students raised several queries. Many were interested in the visa process for studying in Germany, seeking clarity on requirements and procedures. Others inquired

about the quality of master's degree programs in Germany, wanting to understand how these degrees are perceived globally. Students also asked about the job market for graduates, expressing interest in how language proficiency could influence their employment opportunities. Furthermore, there were questions regarding scholarship availability for international students and the support services offered by universities to assist with cultural integration and language learning.

The session concluded with a strong encouragement for students to view learning German not only as a means to enhance their career prospects but also as a gateway to cultural experiences and educational opportunities abroad.
